Protection: It safeguards downstream equipment and users through circuit breakers and RCDs . Load management: By centralizing distribution, it allows for efficient control and monitoring of electrical loads . Construction and large-scale projects: Often used on construction sites or new residential areas to manage temporary or permanent power distribution .
