Ground-mounted boxes should also be slightly elevated (2–4 inches) to prevent moisture damage.

Accessibility: The height should allow operators to read labels, operate switches, and perform maintenance comfortably.

Safety: Avoid wet areas, corrosive environments, or locations prone to accidental impact. Outdoor boxes should be at least 3 feet above ground to prevent water ingress.

Consistency: Within the same building or project, installation heights should be uniform, with allowable deviations typically within 10 millimeters.

Standards Compliance: Follow BS 7671, IEC 60364-5-52, and local building codes to ensure proper installation, safe access, and ergonomic operation.
