

Mobile fiber optic cables and routers are incompatible

- Speed Support:** Older routers with only 1 Gbps ports may limit performance if your fiber plan offers multi-gigabit speeds (2 Gbps, 5 Gbps, or 10 Gbps). Modern Wi-Fi 6 or 6E routers are recommended to fully utilize high-speed fiber.
- Configuration:** Some ISPs may require specific VLAN, DHCP, or PPPoE settings to ensure proper connectivity.

Common Misconceptions

- Being "fiber-ready" does not mean the router can automatically handle all fiber speeds; it primarily indicates that it can accept an Ethernet connection from an ONT.
- You cannot replace the ISP-provided ONT with a traditional modem; the ONT is essential for converting light signals to Ethernet.

Practical Advice

- If you are upgrading to fiber: Confirm that your ISP has installed and activated the ONT.
- Check that your router has a Gigabit or higher WAN port.
- Ensure your router supports the speed tier of your fiber plan.
- Configure any ISP-specific settings.
