Overview

Fiber optic distribution cable is typically required by building code in plenum spaces above drop ceilings or below raised floors, especially in multiunit residential and commercial buildings. It has a higher fire rating than riser cables and is more expensive. The number of fibers in each cable is the same as the number of outlets on the corresponding floor. It requires higher-bandwidths, at greater distances as it interconnects multiple networks through the Main Distribution Area (MDA)/ Main Distribution Frame (MDF) and the Telecommunication Rooms (TRs) / Interconnect. Single family homes, apartments, condominiums and other multi-dwelling units are increasingly wired with fiber optic cable to future-proof installations and create more reliable, higher-bandwidth and faster speed network and video infrastructures. The high-rise multi-dwelling unit (MDU) usually exceeds 10 floors, and the.
