Replace the cotton after 2-3 uses to maintain cleanliness. Proper cleaning prevents signal attenuation and ensures optimal transmission.

Cutting and End-Face Preparation Use precision cutters (manual or electric) to trim the bare fiber. Ensure the cut is clean, without burrs, cracks, or bevels. The quality of the fiber end face is critical for fusion splicing and overall network performance.

Securing and Protection After stripping and cleaning, install cable clamps and sealing components such as heat-shrinkable sleeves to protect fibers from moisture and mechanical stress. Proper alignment of clamps over the metal loose tubes ensures long-term reliability.

Best Practices Always maintain the minimum bending radius to prevent fiber breakage. Work in a clean environment to avoid contamination. Use specialized tools for stripping, cleaving, and cleaning. Follo...
