This method can double the capacity of existing dual-fiber infrastructure and create redundant links between locations.

Passive Fiber Converters

Passive dual-port to single-port converters allow bidirectional transmission for high-speed modules (e.g., 40G/100G LR/ER/ZR) over a single fiber core. These converters are cost-effective for enterprises needing multiple high-speed services without additional fiber installation.

BIDI Transceivers

BIDI SFP/SFP+ modules use two wavelengths (e.g., 1310 nm and 1490 nm) to transmit and receive over a single fiber. They are compatible with standard duplex patch cords but reduce fiber usage by half, making them ideal for long-distance or fiber-constrained environments.

Practical Considerations

Compatibility:

Ensure that the optical module, patch cord, and converter are compatible in terms of wavelength, fiber type (single-mode or multimode), and connector type (LC, SC, MPO, etc.).
