

Outdoor pole installation of distribution boxes

Mount the box securely to the pole using brackets or U-bolts, ensuring it is slightly elevated to prevent water accumulation beneath it. Position the box so that conduit entries are at the bottom or sides to prevent water ingress.

Step 4: Install Conduit and Wiring Use rigid or flexible conduit to protect wires from environmental damage. Seal conduit entries with liquid-tight fittings or cord grips to maintain the box's ingress protection. Ensure all internal connections are made with listed wire connectors and maintain at least 6 inches of free conductor length inside the box. Include proper grounding and bonding: connect the metal enclosure and pole (if metallic) to the grounding system.
