**Best Practices for Patch Cable Management**

- Cable Length Control** Patch cables should have a controlled surplus, typically no more than 500 mm beyond the required connection length. Avoid using cables that are too short or connecting two patch cables with an unapproved flange. Common lengths include 1 m, 2 m, 2.5 m, or 3 m for trunk connections, and 50 cm for user terminal connections.
- Bend Radius and Routing** Maintain a minimum bending radius of 400 mm for all patch cables. Inside the ODF, cables should ascend once inside and once outside without wrapping around multiple spools. Horizontal routing should be below the ODM, and vertical routing should go directly to the corresponding terminal.
- Neatness and Accessibility** Arrange all patch cables inside the ODF frame; external or temporary routing is prohibited. Use cable management rings, guides, and holders to prevent tangling and ensure easy access for moves, adds, or changes. Label all fibers and ports clearly for quick identification.
- Connector and Fiber Type Selection** Choose patch cables based on the connector type (SC-SC, FC-FC, SC-FC) and fiber type (single-mode or multi-mode). E...
