Insert the keystone jack into the patch panel port until it clicks securely.

Step 4: Cable Management Route the cables neatly using a cable manager or organizer attached to the patch panel. Secure cables with zip ties to prevent strain or accidental disconnection. Leave some slack for future adjustments or maintenance.

Step 5: Test and Label Connections Use a network cable tester to verify that each port is correctly wired and functioning. Label each port clearly to indicate the connected device or room, which simplifies troubleshooting and future network changes.

Best Practices Maintain consistent wiring standards across all connections to avoid network issues. Avoid mixing different cable categories or shielding types in the same channel. Keep cable twists intact as close to the termination point as possible...
