

Pigtail wire hot melt



Overview

The most likely cause is a failing blower motor drawing excessive current due to internal shorts. While replacing the melted connector (often with individual female connectors) can temporarily restore function, it's crucial to replace the blower motor to prevent recurrence. In addition, corrosion on the terminals causes high resistance, which can also increase heat to the point.
