Flow test: Observe effluent distribution to ensure all lateral lines receive equal flow. Repair Options Cleaning and leveling: Remove clogs and adjust the box to ensure even distribution (\$200–\$500) Partial repair: Seal minor cracks or replace damaged outlets Full replacement: Install a new D-box if structural damage is severe (\$600–\$2,000), ensuring the replacement matches the original design to maintain proper flow Preventive Measures Schedule regular inspections to catch early signs of failure Avoid overloading the septic system with e...
