Distribution boxes and rooms should be selected and installed according to IP ratings and IEC/BS 7671 standards to ensure protection against dust, water, and electrical hazards.

IP Ratings for Distribution Boxes

The Ingress Protection (IP) code classifies the level of protection an enclosure provides against solids and liquids. The first digit (0–6) indicates protection against dust and solid objects, while the second digit (0–8) indicates protection against water. Common ratings for distribution boxes include:

- IP54:** Dust-protected and protected against splashing water; suitable for most indoor industrial and residential environments.
- IP55:** Dust-protected and protected against low-pressure water jets; used in areas with occasional washdowns or light rain exposure.
- IP65:** Dust-tight and protected against low-pressure water jets; ideal for harsh industrial or outdoor environments.
- IP66:** Dust-tight and protected against powerful water jets; suitable for outdoor or coastal installations with high exposure to water and dust.

Testing for these ratings involves dust chambers, water jets, or immersion tests to ensure the enclosure maintains integrity under real-world conditions.

Standards and Safety Requirements

Distribution boxes and rooms must comply with IEC 61439 and BS 7671 standards, which cover design, testing, and installation.

Accessibility: Panels must be readily accessible for operation, maintenance, and inspection. Recommended mounting height is 1–1.8 meters for residential units, with adjustments for elderly or handicapped users.

Clearance: Adequate working space around the panel is required to ensure safe access and maintenance.

Switchgear Installation: Outdoor installations require enclosures with at least IP4X, IP5X, or IP6X protection if not housed indoors.

Material and Insulation: Use double insulation and covers for live parts, and select corrosion-resistant materials.
