- Clean Connectors:** Use lint-free wipes and isopropyl alcohol to remove dust or oil from connector end faces.
- Verify Connections and Polarity:** Confirm that connectors are fully seated, properly aligned, and that MPO fibers follow the correct key-up/key-down orientation.
- Test Signal Strength:** Use a power meter or OTDR to measure signal loss. Values outside the expected range (typically -15dBm to -30dBm) indicate a problem.
- Use a Visual Fault Locator (VFL):** A VFL emits a visible red laser to trace the fiber path and locate breaks, misalignments, or faulty splices.
- Swap Suspect Equipment:** Replace transceivers or other equipment to rule out hardware issues.
