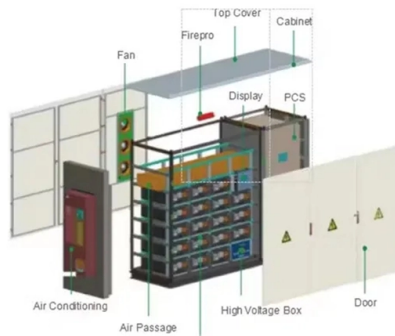


Replacement Time of Network Security Equipment
