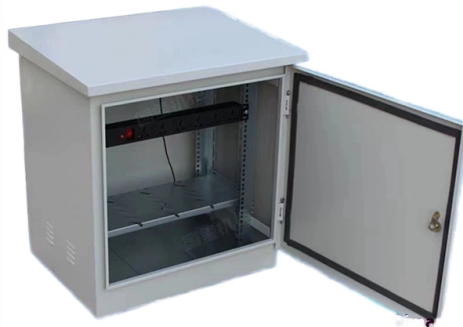

Connect the other end to the optical input port on your receiver, soundbar, or amplifier, often labeled “Optical In” or “Digital In” . Turn on the devices and configure the audio settings. On your TV or source device, select Digital Audio Out and choose PCM or Bitstream depending on your receiver's capabilities . Test the connection by playing audio. If sound comes through the speakers, the connection is successful .

**Improper alignment:** Ensure the cable is lined up correctly with the port; do not force it .

**Damaged cable or connectors:** Inspect for cuts, bends, or broken flaps; replace if necessary .

**Device incompatibility:** Verify that both devices support digital optical connections and the correct format (TOSLINK or mini-TOSLINK), .

**Loose connection:** Firmly insert the cable and check for obstructions or debris in the ports .

**Settings misconfiguration:** Confirm that the source device and receiver are set to use the optical output and input corre...
