The fiber type of the pigtail must match the SFP module's specifications to ensure optimal signal transmission. Pigtail Configuration Simplex pigtails: Single fiber with one connector, suitable for single-channel SFPs. Duplex pigtails: Two fibers with two connectors, required for SFPs that use separate transmit and receive channels, such as 1G or 10G duplex links . Additional Considerations Polarity: For duplex connections, ensure the "A" and "B" fibers are correctly aligned with the SFP's transmit and receive ports . Pre-terminated vs. field termination: Factory-terminated pigtails provide lower insertion...
