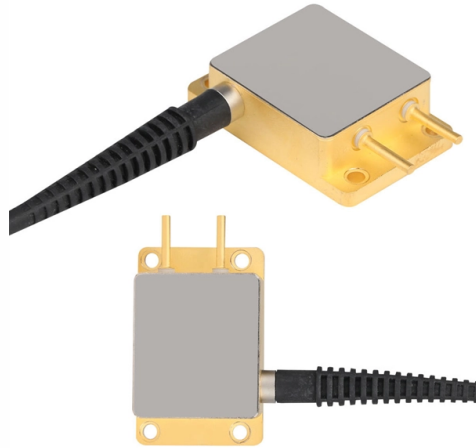


Safety button for the distribution box

Dedicated isolators may also be installed near individual equipment for localized control.

- Quick Access:** Buttons should be positioned for immediate access in emergencies.
- Integration with Safety Systems:** In industrial setups, distribution boxes may include cascaded safety circuits, enunciation circuits, and power/ground circuits to ensure comprehensive protection.
- Maintenance:** Regular testing and inspection are crucial to ensure buttons function correctly and comply with safety standards.

Best Practices

- Ensure all safety buttons are clearly labeled and visible.
- Train personnel on the correct use of emergency stops and isolators.
- Use corrosion-resistant and insulated materials for d...
