Wire arrangement: Group wires by function or routing into harnesses, using cable ties and ducts to maintain neatness . Wire stripping and crimping: Strip insulation appropriately (typically 6-10mm) and use proper terminals for secure connections . Separation of power and signal cables: Prevent interference and ensure safety . Installation and Safety
