When connecting: Ensure the box has sufficient depth (minimum 2 1/8 inches) and is securely mounted. Use listed compatible control panels only. Follow proper wiring practices: strip wires to the recommended length (1/4" to 3/8"), secure under clamping plates, and avoid looping wires under terminals. For non-power-limited applications, a module barrier (e.g., CB500) must be used to separate power-limited and non-power-limited circuits. Break wire runs to provide supervision of connections, ensuring the system can detect open or short circuits.

Safety and Compliance Disconnect power to the control panel before installation. All wiring must conform to local codes, ordinances, and regulations. Supervision is critical; the module must monitor the integrity of the wiring to prevent failures during an emergency. Modules should not be installed in a way that leaves resistors or connections "floating" inside the box.
