- Color Coding:** Use different colored cables for internal vs. external networks or different services to simplify identification.
- Labeling and Documentation:** Label both ends of each cable with port numbers, device names, or asset numbers. Maintain a structured documentation system recording ports, IPs, VLANs, and device locations to comply with ISO/IEC 27001, DIN EN 50600, or industry-specific regulations.
- Cable Management Accessories:** Use zip ties, Velcro straps, or cable sleeves to bundle cables neatly. Ensure that ties are not overly tight to avoid damaging cables.
- Employ patch panels to centralize connections and reduce cable clutter.**
- Airflow and Safety:** Avoid blocking ventilation paths to prevent overheating. Maintain proper spa...
