Low-voltage DB boxes typically handle up to 1000 volts, with most industrial systems operating at up to 600 volts. Proper sizing is critical to prevent overloads and overheating. To determine the correct DB box:

- Calculate total load current by summing all connected circuits, including lighting, appliances, and machinery.
- Consider future expansion to avoid undersizing.
- Select breakers according to voltage requirements: 120V circuits use single-pole breakers, while 240V circuits require double-pole breakers.
- Check short-circuit withstand rating to ensure the box can handle fault currents safely, as per IEC 61439 standards.
