

Standard load switch in distribution box



Overview

Basic load switches consist of four pins: input voltage, output voltage, enable and ground. When the device is enabled via the ON pin, the pass FET turns on, thereby allowing current to flow from the input pin to the output pin, and power is passed to the downstream circuitry. A distribution box is a low-voltage electrical enclosure that receives incoming power and distributes it safely to multiple outgoing circuits through protective and switching devices such as MCBs, RCDs, RCBOs, fuses, isolators, busbars, neutral bars, earth bars, and surge protective devices. They are ideally suited for applications in building-site power distributions, grid and grid back-up feed s telecommunications, hospitals, airports, railroad systems and transport service ith dual switch.
