- Mechanical milling:** Cutting or grinding the dried peel into fine powder (e.g., 250 μm) for use in food or industrial applications.
- Ultrasound-assisted extraction (UAE):** Applying ultrasonic waves to break cell walls and release soluble and insoluble fibers efficiently.
- Enzymatic or chemical treatments:** Optional steps to enhance fiber yield and functional properties, such as solubility and water-holding capacity.

Step 5: Storage Store the extracted fiber in airtight containers to maintain quality and prevent moisture absorption. Proper storage ensures the fiber remains suitable for dietary or industrial use.
