Grounding Requirements Proper grounding is essential for safety. Connect a ground wire from the distribution box to a dedicated grounding bar or mounting plate, and then to the central grounding point of the facility . Ground resistance should be less than 0.1 ohm for system components, and the total grounding system should not exceed 25 ohms to ensure effective dissipation of fault currents . Use appropriately sized wires: typically 10 AWG in the US or 6 mm² elsewhere, with larger conductors for longer cable runs or multiple spindles .
