- Configure the Router:** Access the router's admin panel (e.g., 192.168.1.1) and configure the connection type as instructed by your ISP. Some ISPs require static IP, PPPoE credentials, or automatic detection.
- Verify Connection:** Check the router's indicator lights and test internet access. If the ONT is properly connected, the router should receive a signal and establish a connection.

Common Problems

- Router lacks fiber input:** Standard routers cannot accept fiber directly; an ONT is required.
- Incorrect configuration:** Using the wrong IP settings or failing to enter ISP credentials can prevent connection.
- Faulty fiber outlet or cable:** If the ONT does not detect a signal, the fiber outlet may be inactive or the cable improperly connected.
