- Proximity to equipment:** Tertiary boxes are often installed directly under or near the equipment, which may justify the absence of a door if the box is not exposed to external hazards.

Practical Implications

- Construction sites:** On-site tertiary boxes may be open for ease of access and frequent connection/disconnection of equipment, but they should still be mounted securely and protected from accidental contact or moisture.
- Residential or permanent installations:** Typically, tertiary boxes are enclosed with a door for safety, but in some modular or compact designs, the door may be omitted if the box is integrated into the appliance or equipment housing.
