Each device or outlet is protected individually, following the principle of "one device, one circuit breaker, one RCD, one box".

**Safety and Coordination Principles**

- Current Selectivity:** The upstream breaker's instantaneous trip setting must exceed the maximum fault current of the downstream breaker to prevent unnecessary disconnection.
- Time Selectivity:** Upstream breakers operate with a short delay, while downstream breakers act instantaneously to isolate faults quickly.
- Energy Selectivity:** Current-limiting characteristics of breakers are used to reduce fault energy and protect equipment.
- Leakage Protection:** Terminal circuits must include RCBOs or RCDs to disconnect o...
