Facilitate directional changes and cable routing around obstacles. Joint Couplers / Sleeves Cylindrical or sleeve-type connectors that align and secure tray ends. Commonly used in ladder-type or perforated trays for heavy-duty applications. Material and Compatibility Connecting pieces are typically made from pre-galvanized steel, hot-dip galvanized steel, stainless steel, or aluminum, offering corrosion resistance and durability. Compatibility depends on the tray type (ladder, solid-bottom, ventilated, or wire mesh) and load requirements. Some fittings are designed specifically for heavy industrial use, while others suit commercial or IT infrastructure.
