

Welding machine connection to distribution box

Ensure all connections are tight and secure. Circuit protection: Make sure the distribution box has the correct circuit breakers or fuses for the welding machine's load.

Step 5: Connect the Welding Machine Attach the power cable from the distribution box to the welding machine's input connector. Ensure the plug or cable is fully inserted and secure. Connect the grounding cable from the welding machine to a clean metal surface or designated grounding point. Connect the electrode holder cable to the welding machine's output connector, ens...
