- Underground installation:** Cables are pulled through conduits or ducts beneath streets or sidewalks. Techniques like micro-trenching allow narrow, shallow trenches to minimize disruption and cost, especially in urban areas. Technicians must handle fiber carefully, respecting the minimum bend radius and pulling tension to prevent damage.

Splicing and TerminationSince fiber cables are not continuous, splicing joins sections to allow uninterrupted light transmission. Precision and cleanliness are critical to minimize signal loss. Termination connects the fiber to networking devices, such as optical ne...
