Fire-resistant cabinets are particularly important in industrial or high-power installations where equipment density and electrical load are high. Physical and Structural Requirements Network cabinets must follow industry standards for size, mounting, and spacing to ensure safe installation and airflow: Rack type: Standard 19-inch four-post EIA cabinets or two-post telco racks with universal hole spacing per ANSI/EIA-310-D. Vertical space: Minimum 1U (1.75 in / 4.4 cm) per chassis. Width: At least 17.75 in (45.1 cm) between front mounting posts. Depth: 26–32 in (66–81 cm) between front and back posts to accommodate rack kits. Clearances: Minimum 3 in (7.6 cm) for airflow and cable bend radius; 1 in (25 mm) for module handles. These dimensions ensure proper airflow, prevent overhea...
