Paired Program drives include a small DOS partition with INSTALLR.EXE, PARK.COM, and README.1ST for installation guidance. SCSI ID Assignment: Devices are recognized by their SCSI ID numbers. The default ID for a single drive is 0, and jumpers can be used to change IDs if multiple devices are installed. BIOS and ROM: Early ST01/ST02 versions have an 8K ROM; the 16K version of ST01 includes an auxiliary drive power connector. The ST02 does not include ROM BIOS extensions for floppy support, so DOS must handle floppy operations. Interrupts: A 3-pin jumper (JP5) allows selection or disabling of interrupts, which is recommended for PC/MS-DOS environments. Additional Notes Paired Program Drives: Identified by a "PR" label, these drives are preformatted and may include Disk Manager software for capacities over 32 MB. Transport Precautions: Drives and adapters should be handled carefully to avoid st...
