Use fiber optic connectors (SC, LC, or ST) to terminate fibers for patching to network devices.
- Routing and Managing Fibers** Route fibers along predefined paths inside the box, maintaining proper bend radius to prevent signal loss. Ensure sufficient slack so that the front panel can be fully extended without tension on the fibers; typically, a minimum of 31 inches of fiber length is recommended between key points. Secure fibers with cable ties or movable fasteners to prevent movement and accidental damage. Use jumper troughs or routing guides for organized distribution to multiple ports or adjacent fra...
