4. Visual Fault Locators (VFLs) VFLs emit a visible laser through the fiber to detect breaks, bends, or faults. They allow technicians to trace the fiber path and quickly identify problem areas without physically damaging the cable .
5. Cleaning and Inspection Tools Maintaining clean fiber end faces is crucial. Lint-free wipes, cleaning fluids, cassette cleaners, and inspection scopes help remove contaminants and verify the fiber surface before splicing or connecting. Skipping this step can lead to signal loss .
6. Kevlar Cutters and Cable Jacket Tools Fiber optic cables often contain Kevlar for strength. Specialized Kevlar cutters and cable jacket strippers allow safe removal of these materials without damaging the fiber inside .
