Tray cables (TC, TC-ER, and ITC) are the primary types of cables designed for safe and code-compliant installation in cable trays. Can be installed in cable trays, raceways, and outdoor locations if supported. Flame-retardant and UL listed for hazardous locations and control circuits. Direct burial is allowed if specifically rated.
- TC-ER - Tray Cable with Exposed Run Rating** Designed for short exposed runs (up to 6 feet) between the tray and equipment. Includes impact- and crush-resistant jacketing. Eliminates the need for conduit in certain installations while maintaining code compliance.
- ITC - Instrumentation Tray Cable (NEC Article 727/725)** Used for low-energy control, signal, and communication circuits (typically ≤ 150 volts, 5 amps). Available in shielded or unshielded constructions, often with twisted pairs and optional metal armor. Provides enhanced noise resistance for sensitive instrumentation and PLC/DCS systems. Some ITC cables also have ER ratings for short exposed runs.
