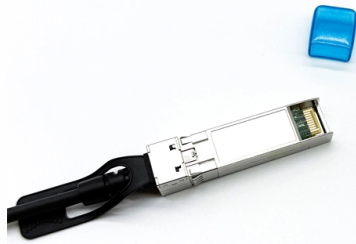


When are fiber optic splice closures used
