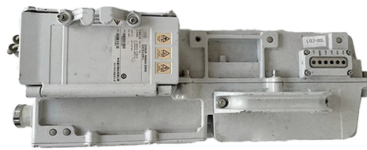

The distance is calculated using the speed of light in the fiber and divided by two to obtain the single fiber length. This method is highly accurate and non-invasive, avoiding physical stress on the fiber.
3. Time-of-Flight Measurement Some laboratories use time-of-flight techniques (non-OTDR) to measure the length of fiber reels accurately. This method relies on precise timing of light pulses traveling through the fiber.
4. Specialized Fiber Length Meters Manufacturers produce dedicated fiber length meters that offer high resolution and repeatability, often accurate to a few millimeters. These devices are suitable for both laboratory and field applications.
5. Indirect Measurement (Coiling) For approximate measurements, the fiber can be coiled, and the coil diameter and number of turns are used to calculate the length using geometry. This method is less precise and assumes uniform cable consistency.
