- 4. Older Fuse Boxes** Traditional fuse boxes, which rely on replaceable fuses instead of circuit breakers, are also being phased out. While fuses themselves are functional, many older installations have been modified to handle modern electrical loads improperly, such as replacing fuses with higher-rated ones or inserting metal objects, creating significant fire hazards.
