Wire Entry Wires entering a distribution box should use designated cable entry points or knockouts in the enclosure to prevent damage to insulation and maintain a neat layout. For safety: Use cable glands or bushings to protect wires from sharp edges of the box. Bind wires with plastic ties at uniform spacing to keep them straight and organized. Label wires for AC, DC, or different voltage levels to facilitate future maintenance and inspections.

Color coding: Neutral wires are blue, phase wires are yellow (A), green (B), and red (C) to comply with standards.
