5. **Connecting Branch Circuits** Wire each outgoing circuit to its corresponding breaker. Maintain a consistent wiring direction: typically, wiring from the main breaker to branch breakers is on the left, and outgoing wires from the box are routed to the right.
6. **Grounding and Earthing** Connect the earth wire from each circuit to the earth bus bar. If available, connect the earth wire from the earthing pit directly to the earth link. Proper grounding is essential for safety and to prevent electrical hazards.
7. **Wire Management** Bind wires neatly using plastic ties, keeping spacing uniform and wires straight. Clearly mark each wire for its function (AC, DC, voltage level, or...
